- Read another book by Steve Antony and do a book review about it


Science

Computing

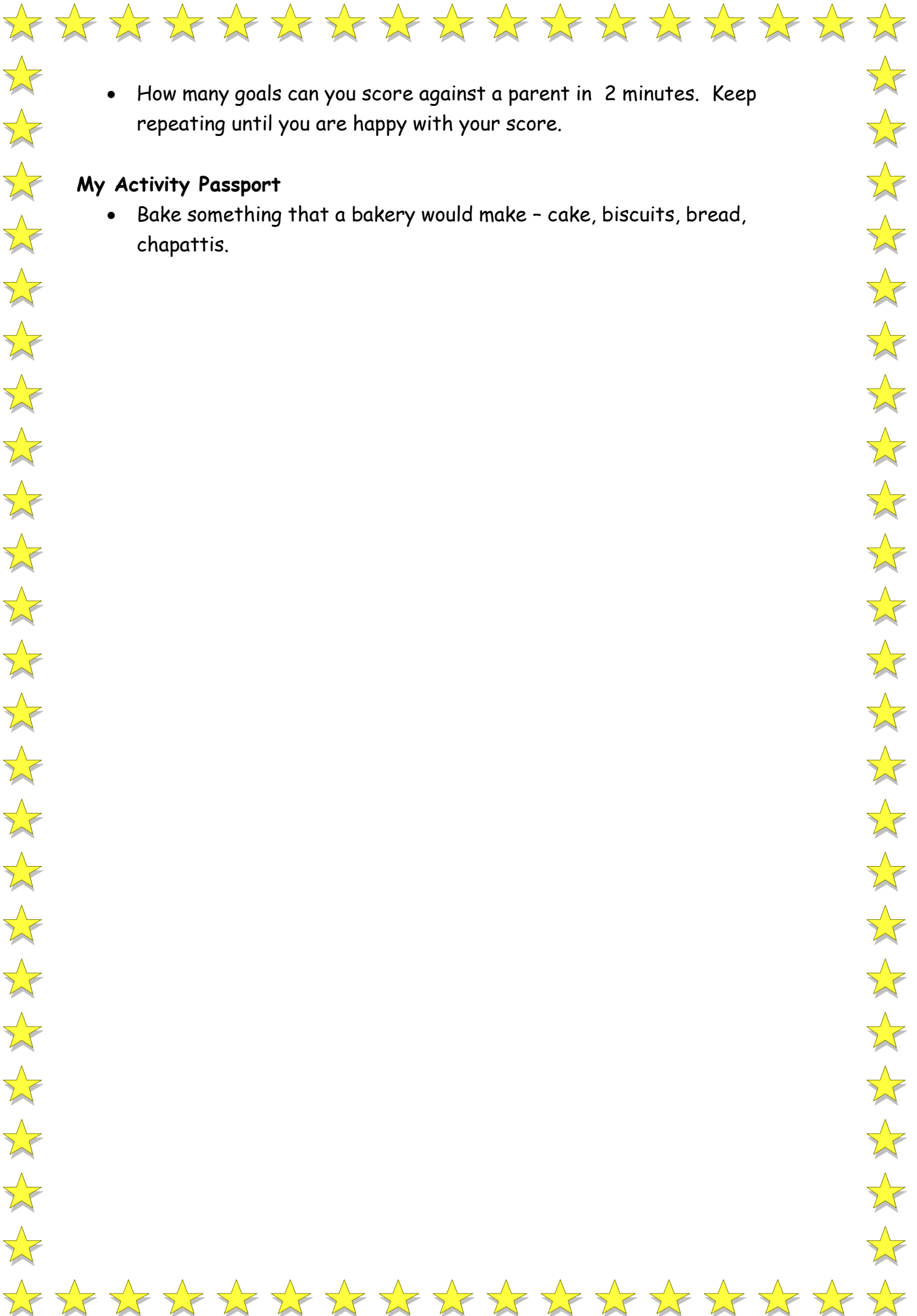
