- Trailing flowering plants (white, blue, pink) such as: Lobelia

We would also like your child to bring in their own planting creation using a piece of kitchenware as a container such as a tea cup, mug, teapot, bowl, jug, cake tin, colander, pan etc. These can be planted in any colour and will be incorporated into our design.

If you could send in your plant donations and child's kitchenware planter into school by Wednesday 5th June this would be greatly appreciated.
