RECEPTION VISIT TO PEAK WILDLIFE PARK - WEDNESDAY 3RD JULY 2019

During the spring term the children learnt a lot about animals from other countries. This trip will enable the children to see some of the animals discussed first hand, such as meerkats, penguins, zebras and lemurs. The children will have the opportunity to observe the animals in their habitat, but also, to learn about how the animals are looked after by the keepers at the Peak Wildlife Park.

We will leave school at 9.30am and will return at 3.00pm.

We request a voluntary contribution of £10.10 to cover the cost of the coach travel and entrance. You can pay via ParentPay or cheques made payable to SUAT or cash to the office.

Activities

Whilst there we will be completing the following activities:

- Walk around the park and observe the animals in their habitats.
- A one hour talk from a ranger about meerkats, penguins and lemurs.

Clothing

Your child will need to come to school dressed appropriately for the trip in:

- School uniform.
- Warm / waterproof coat in case of inclement weather.
- Sun hat if the weather is sunny.

Food and Snacks

All children in reception are eligible for a 'universal free school meal'. Please can we request on this occasion that **all** children have a school packed lunch from school so that the staff can keep all the lunch bags in cool boxes and the children do not have to carry home lunch bags around with them. You will need to order online by Tuesday 25th June 2019. Regardless of what is on the Freshstart menu just order a packed lunch. We will ask the children if they want a wrap of sandwich and what filling they would like.
