Watch Me Learn Wednesday 23rd October 2019

Last year we began our 'Watch Me Learn' sessions in English and Maths, and received positive comments from parents, children and teachers. The sessions were enjoyable for all as it gave **us** a chance to showcase how well your children learn and showed **you** some of the various ways they do this.

We are giving you the opportunity to see your children learn in their classrooms on Wednesday 23rd October 2019.

Key Stage	11.00am - 11.20am

For these sessions the children will be covering an aspect of the Phonics Curriculum. Phonics is taught daily for 20 minutes and has four elements to the lesson. There will be an opportunity for you to watch a recap on previous learning, a teach of something new, a time for the children to practise and then show they can apply what they have learnt.

Due to popularity and Health and Safety reasons we will be limiting places available in each classroom, and adults will only be able to attend one session this time; but don't worry...there will be more 'Watch Me Learn' sessions throughout the year to give you further opportunities to find out how your children are learning in other national curriculum areas. The Nursery will not be taking part on this occasion.
