Dear Parents / Carers

Last year, our Year 4 pupils had a fantastic and memorable residential trip to Standon Bowers. Due to the success we are excited to offer the same to the current year 4 children.

Some of the activities that will be on offer are: -

- Caving
- Climbing
- Archery
- Team building activities
- Night walk

The school PTFA have kindly agreed to cover the cost of the transport so the cost of this trip is £116.85. We will need a non-refundable deposit of £35.00 to be paid by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at the latest. If your child will not be taking part, please let the school office know by this date also. We propose the following payment scheme so the cost is split: -

- £35.00 Non-refundable deposit to be paid by Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October 2019 at the latest.
- £21.00 Payable by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> January 2020.
- £21.00 Payable by Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February 2020.
- £21.00 Payable by Friday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
- £18.85 Payable by Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2020.

Payments for the trip must be made via ParentPay.

Closer the time we will be holding a parents/child meeting and will be sending out medical forms, but please be aware in advance that any non-prescribed medicine e.g. Hayfever relief, calpol or nurofen will need a dosage label on from a pharmacy.

**Please do not book a school dinner via FreshStart for your child for these 3 days.**

### **KIT LIST**

Single duvet cover and pillow case

**The centre provide the actual duvet and pillow to use.**

Towel x1

Toiletries bag – toothbrush / toothpaste / soap / hairbrush etc..

Night wear

Underwear / socks

T-Shirts / tops x4 – at least one with long sleeves

Sweatshirts x2 and a light weight top depending on the weather.

Trousers / jeans / jogging bottoms x3

Change of clothes for the evening activities

Waterproof jacket and trousers (if you have them)

Sturdy shoes or wellingtons

Pair of old trainers x1

Large plastic bag for dirty washing

Gloves / Hat / Scarf if inclement weather

Water bottle

Hat and sunscreen if the weather is good

Cuddly toy for bedtime if needed
