KS1 VISIT TO GLADSTONE POTTERY MUSEUM – WEDNESDAY 4TH MARCH 2020

This term KS1 children are reading ‘The Flower’ as part of our topic on how things grow. We are also learning about plants in art and links to the Potteries. To help us explore the history of the Potteries we will be taking the Robins, Frogs and Bats classes to Gladstone Pottery Museum on Wednesday 4th March 2020. Year 1 will be painting plates in the style of Clarice Cliff and Year 2 will make a flower from clay. We will also all have a tour of the museum to find out what life was like for a potter.

We will leave school at 9.10am after registration and return back for 3.15pm home time collection at the latest.

We request a voluntary contribution of £7.50 to cover the cost of access to the event. The PTFA will fund the coach travel for the children. Please make your payment via ParentPay by Friday 28th February 2020. **Please note that if we do not receive sufficient funds, this trip will be unable to go ahead.**

- Y2 making a flower from clay

Clothing

Your child will need to come to school dressed appropriately for the trip in:

- Warm / waterproof coat and school shoes in case of inclement weather.

All children in Key Stage 1 are eligible for a ‘universal free school meal’. You will need to order online by Tuesday 25th February 2020 at the latest.
