### Purpose and values of department

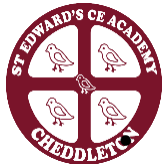

### Statement of Purpose

- Delivering energy conservation practices in line with the County Council's corporate climate change strategy.

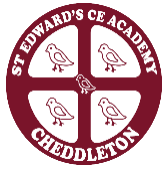
#### **Health and Safety**
