- Provide homework in accordance with the Academy homework expectations
- Notify parents of any concerns relating to their child's progress or conduct

AS A PARENT/CARER I/WE WILL:

- Respect staff and other families' culture, race, feelings, beliefs and values
- Ensure that my child attends the academy every day, on time and with everything s/he needs or;
Inform the academy immediately of any absence and provide evidence for this to be authorised
- Not arrange holidays in term-time
- Let the academy know of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's learning, behaviour or well-being
- Attend consultation meetings to review my child's progress
- Support the academy's rules and expectations as set out in the Behaviour Policy
- Ensure that my child reads regularly at home and record this in their log
- Ensure that my child's homework is completed and returned on time
- Ensure that my child wears the correct uniform each day
- Ensure the academy is notified of any change in emergency contact numbers
- Support the academy in the teaching of safe and secure internet use at school and home
- Adhere to the academy's policy on the use of social media
