KS2 VISIT TO THE WORLD MUSEUM LIVERPOOL - TUESDAY 7TH MARCH 2023

This term in KS2 we are reading, 'The Egyptian Cinderella' as part of our English learning and learning about Ancient Egypt in our History unit. To help us explore the history of the Ancient Egyptians in more depth we will be taking the Foxes, Spiders and Squirrels classes to The World Museum on Tuesday 7th March. All children will be taking part in a 'Meet the Mummy' workshop and will have the opportunity to explore the Ancient Egyptian artefacts along with the other interesting exhibits the museum has to offer.

Due to the distance that we need to travel to get to the museum, we will need to leave school at 8am, so we ask that all children are in school **by 7.50am on Tuesday 7th March** to ensure they can use the toilet and can be registered before getting on the coach. We aim to arrive back at school by 4.30pm but will update on Class Dojo class stories if we face any delays.
