

Summer 1 2023 - Happily Ever After

Please choose a minimum of 3 activities to complete over the half term. Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child's portfolio on Class Dojo rather than sending it in to school at this time. Your child's teacher or a Child Champion will look at the portfolios weekly to see what your child has been doing. If you require an exercise book to do this work in please message your child's class teacher.

- **Literacy - YN** - Write **your name** on an invitation to a fairy tale ball. **YR** - write **your full name and address** on an invitation to a fairy tale ball.
- **UtW: People, Culture & Communities** - Find out how and why people celebrate May Day, what traditional activities do they take part in?
- **UtW: Past & Present** - Find something in your house that your parents used/played with when they were a child. How is this the same, different from the things we have/play now?
- **UtW: The Natural World** - Observe the changes taking place in your garden or in the park. What is happening to the trees and plants? What animals, insects have you seen? Take photographs or a video to show what you have seen.
- **EAD: Creating with Materials** - Create a model of 'The Three Bears Cottage', 'Jack's beanstalk' or the 'Giant's castle'.
- **EAD: Performance** - Become the giant from Jack and the Beanstalk, what does he sound like, how does he move? Upload a video to show your performance.
- **PSED: Managing Self** - Learn how to make your own bed.
- **Active PE** - Develop your underarm throwing and catching skills. How many times can you throw and catch your ball without dropping it in a minute?
- **My Activity Passport** - Make a paper boat and see if it floats.
- **UtW: RE** - When have you or your family been to church? What was the occasion/reason? Share a photograph of the event you or your family attended.
- **UtW/EAD: The Coronation of King Charles III** - Find out how people in this country and around the world will be celebrating the coronation. Design and make a crown to wear to your families 'Coronation Celebration'. Upload photographs to your Dojo portfolio.
