



The home learning opportunities below, relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose from the suggested activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child's portfolio on Clasdojo so your child's teacher or Child Champion can see what your child has been doing. If you require an exercise book to do this work in, please message your child's class teacher.

- **Literacy** – Take a photograph of you reading your favourite book outdoors – this could be in your garden, at the park or on a trip out with your family. Tell us why this book is your favourite.
- **Maths** – Collect natural objects to represent numbers to 5 (Nursery) and 10 (Reception) eg 1 stick, 3 conkers, 5 leaves etc.
- **Understanding the World: People Culture and Communities** – Find out who are the emergency services in our community and how they help us.
- **Understanding the World: Past and Present** – Create a family tree to show the members of your family.
- **Understanding the World: The Natural World** – Find out what happens in Autumn eg go on an Autumn walk, research what happens to the animals and trees at this time of year.
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Creating with Materials** – Carve a pumpkin and upload in a photo to show off your creation.
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Performance** – Sing a number song (nursery rhyme) to your family – upload a video of your performance.
- **PSED: Managing Self** – Learn how to put on and fasten your coat by yourself.
- **Physical: Active PE** – Create your own obstacle course indoors/outdoors. Upload a video/picture of you completing it.
- **My Activity Passport** – Taste a new fruit or vegetable. Be prepared to tell your class what you thought about it!
- **UtW: RE** – Research - Why do we celebrate Harvest? What do the farmers have to do at harvest time? Upload any information, drawings, photographs.
