



## Nursery SEAC Mental Maths Homework for Autumn Term 1







This half term your child will be working on these targets  
in their mental maths learning.

<b>Counting numbers 1 and 2</b>
<b>Recognising numbers 1 and 2</b>

The minimum expectation of engagement in mental maths homework is the same as reading.

**5 times a week for at least 5 minutes each session.** Below are some suggestions for activities you could do in a 5-minute session.

Verbal	Practical	Written
Sing the Noah's ark song.  <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0mrbhsusOGM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0mrbhsusOGM</a>	Shout out an action (E.g, jump or hop) for number 1 or 2, ask your child to complete that action to the correct number.	Write the numbers 1 and 2 in pencil (large), ask your child to write over yours in a different colour pencil.
Ask your child to repeat the number you say.	Ask your child to mirror your actions in the air, writing 1 or 2.	Write the number 1 or 2 in sand, soil, flour etc. Can your child say what number it is?
Out of the house, maybe on a walk, can they spot numbers 1 or 2 in the environment, E.g Car registrations, house doors, on road signs.	Finding items around the house or in the garden, E.g. 1 piece of Lego or 2 socks.	Watch this video with your child 'The number 2'. Ask questions E.g How many arms do you have? How many noses do you have?
