



The home learning opportunities below, relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose from the suggested activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child's portfolio on ClassDojo so your child's teacher or Child Champion can see what your child has been doing. If you require an exercise book to do this work in, please message your child's class teacher.

- English – Read the Pied Piper of Hamelin poem by Robert Browning – [LINK](#) - Explain which version of the story is your favourite and why.
- Science – Create an instrument, using recycled materials, that can change the pitch when played differently. For example, using straws of different length put together so that different sounds are made when they are blown on.
- Geography – Challenge your parents to name as many different rivers as possible in England – make sure you check their answers carefully.
- History – Visit the Railway station in Cheddleton and explain to an adult how locomotives have changed over time.
- D&T – Design and make a card that has a lever element to make part move. This could be a birthday or Christmas card.
- RE/PSHE - Make an advent wreath and label what each candle represents
- Computing/Online Safety - Access the 2Do's on Purple Mash to develop your touch-typing skills.
- Music - Listen to different compositions by your favourite composer. Explain which is your favourite / least favourite and why.
- Active PE - Create a sequence of balances which include a paired balance and a 1, 2 or 3 point balance.
- MFL (KS2) - Complete the French 2Do's on Purple Mash which will test your sticky knowledge.
