- English- Create a set of instructions of how to make a sandwich at home.

- History – Which of the nurses would you prefer to be and why? (Edith Cavell / Mary Seacole / Florence Nightingale).
- DT – Design and / or create a new, exciting recipe using pumpkins.
- RE – Can you create your own Rangoli pattern using different materials or mediums?
- PSHE- Create an anti-bullying poster which is suitable for Year 1 children.
- Computing/Online Safety- Tell your trusted adult about the things that we must remember when online.
- Music - Listen to different musical compositions and pick which songs best describe the characters feelings at different points in the story.
- Active PE - Practise different balances, turns and movements based on African animals.
