



The home learning opportunities below, relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose from the suggested activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child's portfolio on ClassDojo so your child's teacher or Child Champion can see what your child has been doing. If you require an exercise book to do this work in, please message your child's class teacher.

- English – Imagine you had crawled through a disused tunnel. Write a 250-word story about what happened on the other side.
- Science – create a list of appliances in your house that run solely on battery.
- Geography – Research the human and physical features of a country from around the world and compare it to the United Kingdom.
- History – research why the 'Home front' was an important factor in Britain during World War Two.
- Art – create a piece of art based on Van Gogh's Sunflower.
- RE/PSHE - Research the 5 pillars of Islam and make a presentation about how each pillar is important to Muslims.
- Computing/Online Safety - Explain to an adult at home how to stay safe online.
- Music - Listen to a piece of music that has been created for charity. How has it helped make the world a better place?
- Active PE – Choreograph and perform a dance using World War Two as the stimuli.
- MFL (KS2) - In French, ask family members what different hobbies they participate in.
