Spring 1 – ‘Where My Wellies Take Me’

The home learning opportunities below relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose a minimum of 3 activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child’s portfolio on Clasdojo so your child’s teacher or Child Champion can see what your child has been doing.

- **Literacy** – Listen to some stories about wellies on YouTube. Which was your favourite and why?
- **Understanding the World: People, Culture and Communities** – Go on a walk around the local area in your wellies. Identify and talk about the different features/ landmarks that you see on your journey eg. the church, the tearoom, farms, the canal, etc.
- **Understanding the World: Past and Present** – Look at an old photograph of that shows the inside of your parents/grandparents/great-grandparents home. Compare it with your home now. What is the same? What is different?
- **Understanding the World: The Natural World** – Explore your own garden. Compare it to someone else’s or to the park. What is the same? What is different?
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Creating with Materials** – Paint a winter picture. Can you use your colour mixing skills to help?
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Performance** – Learn a song that you can perform in front your class.
- **PSED: Managing Self** – Learn to put your own gloves on.
- **Physical: Active PE** – How many jumps can you do in 30 seconds? Can you do more or less jumps when wearing your wellies? Try to beat your score each week.
- **My Activity Passport** – Find where you live on a map.
- **UtW: RE** – When have you, or a family member, been to church? What was the reason for going eg. a wedding, a Christening, other special event, a Sunday morning service? Look at photos/discuss what happened and what you/they saw.
