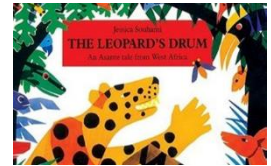


Key Stage 1- Spring 1 The Leopard's Drum

English – Read stories about different types of animals. Which was your favourite and why?

Geography – Where is Africa? Find the name of the Oceans that surround it.

History – Make your own quiz / game using true or false style questions about Christopher Colobus.

Music / DT – Make a musical instrument that you can play. Think about the beat and rhythm while you play.
