Summer 1 – ‘Around the world in half a term’

The home learning opportunities below relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose a minimum of 3 activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child’s portfolio on Clasdojo so your child’s teacher can see what your child has been doing.

- **Literacy – Nursery** - Using the correct letter formation, write your first name.
Reception - Using the correct letter formation, write your full name.
- **Understanding the World: People, Culture and Communities** – Find a story that is set in another country. Share the story with your grown-ups and tell us something that you have learnt about another country.
- **Understanding the World: Past and Present** – Look at an old photograph of your parents/grandparents/great-grandparents when they were on holiday. Talk about what is the same and different to your holiday. How did they get there? Where did they stay? What did they do?
- **Understanding the World: The Natural World** – Observe the changes taking place in your garden or in the park. What is happening to the trees and plants? What animals, insects have you seen? Take photographs or a video to show what you have seen.
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Creating with Materials** – Make a model, or draw/ paint/ colour a picture, of a famous landmark.
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Performance** – Songs/dances from around the world. Learn a song or dance and perform it for your family. Take a video and upload it to dojo.
- **PSED: Managing Self** – Learn how to make your own bed.
- **Physical: Active PE** – Develop your underarm throwing and catching skills. How many times can you throw and catch your ball without dropping it in a minute?
- **My Activity Passport** – Taste a new fruit. Find out where in the world this fruit grows.
