

## EYFS Nursery/Reception

### Summer 2 – ‘All Creatures Great and Small’

The home learning opportunities below relate to the units of learning we are teaching in school. Please choose a minimum of 3 activities to complete this half term.

Take a photo of the activity and add it to your child’s portfolio on Clasdojo so your child’s teacher can see what your child has been doing.

- **Literacy** – Share a story about an animal/minibeast. Can you retell this story in your own words? What happened at the beginning, in the middle and at the end? What was your favourite part of this story?
- **Understanding the World: People, Culture and Communities** – Find out where the Olympics are taking place, tell us a fact about the country and make the national flag.
- **Understanding the World: Past and Present** – Ask your parents about the toys/games they played with as a child. How are they the same or different from the toys/games you play with?
- **Understanding the World: The Natural World** – Minibeast Safari – look closely in your garden or when out on a walk. Can you spot any minibeasts? How are they the same as each other? How are they different?
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Creating with Materials** – Draw/paint a minibeast or use playdough to make a minibeast.
- **Expressive Arts & Design: Performance:**
  - Nursery** - Perform your favourite song or nursery rhyme.
  - Reception** – Share your favourite memory/memories of your time in Early Years.
- **PSED: Managing Self** – Make a healthy picnic lunch box.
- **Physical: Active PE** – Penalty shoot-out - How many goals can you score in 2 minutes?
- **UtW: RE** – Upload a photo showing how you care for God’s creation, eg. looking after animals, watering plants, litter picking, etc.
- **My Personal Development Passport** – Learn how to make a sandwich at home.
