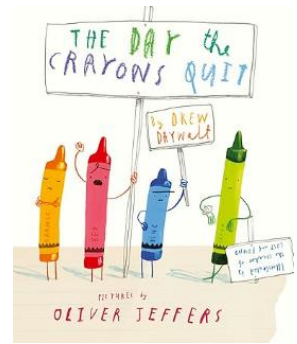


## Key Stage 1- Summer 2
