- Science – Draw a picture / diagram of a flowering plant then label all the different parts. How detailed can you be when drawing and labelling the different parts? Can you name the parts inside the actual flower? Write the functions of the different parts of the flowering plant.
- Geography – Locate a country and research the human and physical features. Create a fact file about your chosen country. You could link your sticky knowledge of mountains in to your fact file.
- History – Create a non-fiction book all about the D-Day landings.
- Art – Create a Henri Rousseau inspired rainforest image.
- RE- Plan to do at least one kind act each week that you think that Jesus would be proud of.
- Computing – Conduct research in your family about their favourite food or hobby. Turn this research into a spreadsheet using 2calculate.
- Music- Listen to and compare music from different countries. Do you have a favourite?
- French- Create a shopping list, written in French. Include different fruits and vegetables.
