**Age range years 5-8 or 9-13**

### Size of artwork

Your entry should not be smaller than **A4 (29.7cm x 21.0cm)** or larger than **A2 (59.4cm x 42.0cm)** even if mounted. Please submit your artwork in flat format only, it should not be rolled, folded or framed.

### Use of Materials

You may use any type of paper, white, coloured , rough or smooth. The work that you submit may be drawn or painted in pencil, charcoal, pen and ink, crayon, pastel, watercolour, acrylics, oils, poster colour and collage. Alternatively, it may be submitted on canvas or in digital format in any artwork software (submit digital to [rotary.leek@btinternet.com](mailto:rotary.leek@btinternet.com))

### Originality

Your work should be original and unaided. Please do not copy another person's work. Any source imagery must be indicated at time of entry

### Number of Entries

You may submit up to one entry per individual. Only individual entries will be accepted and they may be submitted by you or by your school.

### Information Required

**You should include the following information on the back of your entry:**

- Please hand your entry and details to your class teacher with your name, age and school written clearly
- Signature of your parent, teacher or guardian.
- Please note your age is as of the closing date of the Competition (Date 10<sup>th</sup> March 2026).

### The Closing Date

The closing date for receipt of entries is March 10<sup>th</sup> 2026. We are able to collect entries.
